





Who are we?

NODA was founded in 1899, "to protect and advance the interests of operatic and dramatic art, and of societies engaged therein". Our membership continues with over 2,000 society members and over 1,000 individual enthusiasts staging musicals, operas, plays, concerts and pantomimes in venues ranging from the country's leading professional theatres to village halls.

What do we do?

We support and inspire amateur theatre. Our vision is that amateur theatre is successful and sustainable, providing a range of opportunities for people to develop their skills, and enjoy taking part, at all levels.

Mission

NODA's mission is to support the education and information needs of individuals and organisations with high quality services and products that contribute to the success of amateur theatre as well as encouraging appreciation of the sector by participants and audiences alike.
